GODSIGHT-Part 2

Jesus said, "Unless a man is born again, he cannot see the Kingdom of God." **John 3:3** This implies that we must be able to see into the Kingdom with our born again spirit! Godsight is part of the package we receive when we are saved!

In my first article on Godsight I (Rick) gave you an introduction into what it is and the differences between Godsight and our natural sight which is influenced by our experiences and worldly views. Now I want to explore why Godsight is so important to our Christian walk, being able to stay relational, and to be at peace and rest regardless of what is happening around us. Again, a lot of what I will be sharing here was strongly influenced by the book *Victorious Emotions – Creating a Framework for a Happier You* by Wendy Backlund 2017.

Godsight is Seeing Past the Words on the Page

For God's Word to cancel the negative cellular memory or destroy the strongholds in our brain, it must become an image on our heart first and not just words we memorize and confess. Memorization is a left-brain function devoid of emotions, feelings, or images; they're just stored as words, definitions, symbols, or numbers. For the Word to become "living and powerful" we have to see what the Word is doing in our life, which is a right-brain function. In the Hebrew language all letters are represented by pictures, all words are action words and sentences become full-color, mini action movies! These images from God's Word will produce revelations, beliefs, and positive healthy feelings and emotions like love, hope and joy that will pull down strongholds and destroy the works of the devil in our lives and others. It was always easy for me to memorize and quote scripture over situations in my life, but they would often seem shallow and after a while if I didn't see any results, I would begin to question their effectiveness. Now as I have been walking through recovery from two herniated discs, I have begun to see myself in the healing scriptures and I have great peace, hope and expectancy in receiving complete healing in my body! Like the lame man Paul commanded to get up and walk, I see myself jumping, leaping and worshiping Father! **Acts 3:6-9**

Words are more than just black letters on a page. What is in the white is more important than the printed words! We need to feel and experience what God or someone else was experiencing when they wrote those words.

We need to ask ourselves why the author wrote what he did and not something else. Why did he say it that way? What did he mean by those words? Where is the author taking me? When you are reading the Bible, see yourself in those scriptures or observing what is going on. See yourself doing the works that Jesus and the disciples did. See yourself walking in the fruit of the Spirit and flowing in the gifts of the Spirit until the supernatural becomes the natural in your life! The more I have been doing this, the more excited I get seeing myself praying and laying hands on people. Just as Jesus said in **John 14:10**, “...but the Father who dwells in me does the works.”

Our Heart Has to Be Engaged

There's another point worth including here when it comes to allowing the scriptures to change your life. ***We can only be where our heart is; we can't be anywhere else!*** That is why we can be carrying a tool in our hand and lay it down to do something and just minutes later we can't remember where we laid it! Our heart was already somewhere else when we laid the tool down. Or someone can say something to us, and if we are involved in some other activity when they say it, minutes later we can't remember anything they just said! There have been times when I can read a passage of scripture, close my Bible or pause to consider what I just read, and can't remember a word of it! Either something in the passage triggered another thought or I was already thinking about what I need to do after my devotions, and my heart was not in the words that I was reading. I can do the same thing with a book I'm reading and miss the chance to have a heart-to-heart communication with the author. I need to keep my heart engaged in what I'm reading, pausing often to focus on the images or revelations being produced that seem to jump off the page into my heart. And I can keep putting myself into those verses or book that I am reading. When I do that, those scriptures or portions of books will come back instantly to me later on because they are engraved on my heart and help change the current situations around me. Reading with your heart goes beyond definitions and mere words on a page!

Godsight Sees Our True Identity

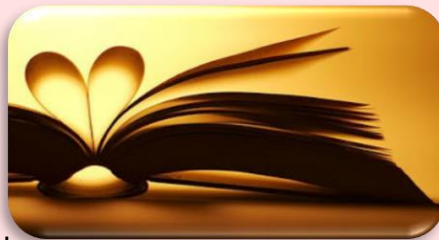
Most of us don't know who we are, only what we have become. Our identity is based upon what we have done or what has happened to us. We see ourselves through the lens of past experiences, what we have been told, or we imagined instead of who we are according to God's

Word. ***Churches do a good job telling us what to do, but seldom do they tell us who we are!*** As we continue to focus on either all the negative images and experiences or all the positive ones, we begin to build strongholds that begin to control our emotions, actions and thoughts about ourselves. The Bible is very clear about who we are. ***We are all sons and daughters of the Most High God through faith in Jesus and He is our Father! Gal. 3:26, 2 Cor. 6:18*** Knowing that I'm Father's son and that He loves me as much as He loves Jesus has completely changed my life. **John 17:23** I never had a good relationship with my natural father, so it's been a real learning curve to see myself having a loving Heavenly Father who is always good, provides everything that I need and protects me from all evil. It's been an awesome adventure just letting go and letting Father take care of everything! It has taken all the fear, anxiety, stress and pressure off of me!

Ungodly Beliefs are anything we believe that does not agree with the Word of God. We can pick up ungodly beliefs from just about any source whether it's the news, family, friends, churches, books or from painful or traumatic events in our own life.

Our beliefs impact our emotions and influence our choices in life. Ungodly beliefs, especially about ourselves, often produce negative emotions that drain us of all energy, stop us from doing things, change how we see ourselves, and prevent us from thinking logically and creatively. Instead, we try to stop or avoid the negative emotions or we try to numb them with addictive behaviors. I used to withdraw and hide my emotions because I was afraid of someone rejecting me when they found out who I thought I was based on my ungodly beliefs about myself.

We can change these negative emotions by changing the ungodly beliefs that produced them. As we search and meditate on the scriptures, Godsight will help us reveal the TRUTH about what we believe and who we are. We can form Godly Beliefs which will produce positive, energizing thoughts and emotions, abounding in creativity. We begin to walk in victory as true sons and daughters. With Godsight we have a positive attitude and see a good future. We can feel Father's love and approval and see life's circumstances through the lens of Father's faithfulness and goodness.

My core Godly Beliefs and Godsight now determine how I feel and what I am going to do even in difficult circumstances!

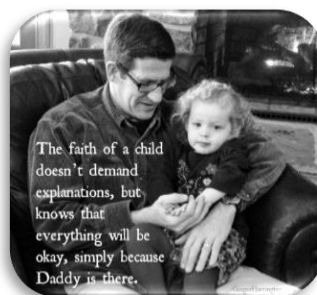
