Update on Well Water Project - Zambia!

We wanted to share an update on the well project in Ndola, Zambia. We had shared that the Lord had put on our hearts to help our friend, Eunice, in Zambia to drill a well on her property to supply clean drinking water for Abba's School of Hope, her church and the surrounding community. From the estimate she sent us, we believed Father would provide the \$3,200 by the end of 2019 so the well could be dug this year. PTL! All of that amount came in by the close of the year. As we prepared to send Eunice the money, however, she shared that because they had been having a very severe drought the well had to be drilled deeper and would now cost \$5,100. Since last June, the well costs had already gone up a few hundred dollars, so we decided to take the extra amount out of our ministry account before the cost rose again.

However, before she committed to a contract with a certain company to drill the well, we suggested she speak with a mutual friend who has a school and had a well dug. He got back to her this week sharing there are different kinds of wells and that it would be best to have an industrial well dug. None of us knew there were different kinds of wells, but we are thankful for His timing and for all the wisdom He is supplying! The estimate that Eunice sent us this week for the industrial well is much more detailed. We can see how important it is to have an industrial well on the property to fulfill her vision for the future! The cost for this kind of well is an additional \$5,300 from what has already come in! We are letting you be aware of the difference that we are believing to see Father bring in to be able to complete this project! We covet your prayers asking the angels to bring in the funds.
